

## East Hampton Garden Club Photography Rules

1. The show is open to members of the Garden Club of East Hampton as well as members of other Garden Club of America Clubs.
2. An exhibitor may make only one entry in a class but may enter more than one class. All entries are limited to the subjects suggested by the class titles.
3. Photographs that have previously won a blue ribbon may not be entered again.
4. Each photograph must be the work of the exhibitor, under whose name it is entered. Matting, mounting and printing may be done professionally.
5. Advance registration by e-mail or mail must be submitted no later than the June 23, 2008. See separate Entry Form.
6. Manipulation at the time of exposure, in the dark room, by computer, or in the printing process is allowed in all classes, and must be the work of the exhibitor. This includes cropping of the image, enhancement for color or clarity, removal of a part of the image, combining images or distorting the original subject.
7. All photographs must include plant material. If the plant material is featured, the common and botanical name(s) are required on the back of the photograph.
8. **MAXIMUM PHOTO SIZE** is 5 x 7 inches. The surface finish of the photo is the choice of the exhibitor. Photo may be mounted on foam core or mat board. If surrounded by a mat (color is the choice of exhibitor) the overall maximum size is to be no larger than 8"x 10".  
If photo is an unusual shape, the total perimeter dimension may be no larger than 36". Each entry must be labeled on the back of the photograph or mounting (lower right hand side please) with the exhibitor's name, address, phone number, e-mail, GCA Club, Zone, and classes entered and location of where photo taken. The top of the photograph must be indicated.

9. If the photograph is to be returned, the exhibitor must provide a self addressed return label, envelope, postage and packing material.
10. The committee may reclassify an entry but only with the permission of the photographer. The Photography Committee and the Judges may subdivide a class but the Judges may not reclassify an entry.
